### The Traditional Swiss Perspective

Based on the Swiss Domestic Law on MLA «IMAC»



Assistance is given to a specific Country

Limited assistance in fiscal matters

Use of Swiss evidence only in requesting Country.

Assistance based on Treaties and Conventions



EPPO is not a country, but a EU body

EPPO largely investigates on fiscal matters

Evidence used in all participating Member States

EPPO / EU are not parties to the Treaties and Conventions

#### Adaptation of the IMAC on 1.6.2021

Swiss Domestic Law on MLA («IMAC») – art. 1 par. 3ter IMAC

3ter The Federal Council may also stipulate in an ordinance that this Act applies by analogy to procedures for cooperation on criminal matters with other international courts or other inter- or supranational bodies with criminal justice functions if:

a.

the court or body is established on the basis of legal provisions that clearly define the powers of court or body in terms of criminal law and criminal procedure; b.

the procedure before the court or body guarantees compliance with the principles of the rule of law; and

C.

cooperation serves to safeguard Switzerland's interests.

### Executive order (15.2.2023)

**Ordinance on Cooperation with EPPO** 

The Executive has designated the EPPO as eligible to receive cooperation under the IMAC
